



Appeals Process

- Authors are asked to write a letter of appeal and resubmit their application in revised form taking into account reviewers' and Grants Committee's comments. The dates for resubmissions are January 31st and June 30th every year.
- In their letter applicants should outline why the BSRF should reconsider its decision; what the clinical benefits of the research might be; and any other reasons why the research is important. It should also contain a detailed response to every point raised by the reviewers and the Committee.
- The revised application should include what has been modified.
- The appeal will then be reviewed by the Grants Committee and if it agrees to reconsider the application, then it will be reviewed by external experts.
- The Grants Chair will then present the case at the next available BSRF meeting for reconsideration.
